Myth	Mythological creature
He is the son of the master craftsman Daedalus. He tried to escape from Crete by using wings that his father constructed from feathers and wax. He ignored instructions not to fly too close to the sun, and the melting wax caused him to fall into the sea where he drowned.	
In Greek tradition, it has the head of a lion, the wings of a great bird, and the face of a woman. Those who cannot answer her riddle are killed and eaten by this monster.	
She is commonly known as the Oracle of Delphi. She was the priestess at the Temple of Apollo at Delphi, located on the slopes of Mount Parnassus. She was widely known for her prophecies inspired by Apollo.	
In Greek mythology she was a monster, a Gorgon, generally described as having the face of a hideous human female with living venomous snakes in place of hair. Gazing directly upon her would turn you to stone.	
According to the myth, she opened a jar out of simple curiosity releasing all the evils of humanity.






